

Floyd Butler Dies in Crane

Floyd F. Butler, 54, of Gulf Camp, Crane, died at 8 o'clock Friday morning of a heart attack.

Funeral services were held Saturday morning at the Church of Christ, Crane, with Hubbard Funeral Home in charge of arrangements. The body was moved to Eastland County for burial after the services.

Butler is survived by his wife, his mother and father, Mr. and Mrs. A. L. Butler of Carbon; four sons, Halsey of Sundown, Pat, J. T., and Finish of Crane; a brother, Ike Butler of Carbon; and a sister, Mrs. Elna Gregg of Oil Center.
