

James F. Moseley Rites are Slated

RANGER - Funeral for James Frank (Kid) Moseley, 82, a lifelong Eastland County resident, will be held at 3 p.m. Wednesday at the Mesquite and Rusk Streets Church of Christ.

Mr. Moseley died at 9:05 a.m. Monday in Ranger General Hospital, where he had been a patient one week.
