RANGER - Myrta Love of Ranger, the first woman to serve as a Farm Bureau agent in Texas, died Friday at a Ranger nursing home. She was 87.

Graveside service will be at 11 a.m. today at Alameda Cemetery, southeast of Ranger. Edwards Funeral Home in Ranger is in charge of arrangements.

In addition to acting as a former Eastland County Farm Bureau agent, Mrs. Love also was a teacher in the Mingus and Chaney public schools for a number of years.

Mrs. Love was born in Jayton, Kent County, and graduated from Jayton High School. She attended the University of Texas at Austin and had lived in the Ranger area most of her life. Mrs. Love was a member of Mesquite and Rusk Streets Church of Christ in Ranger.
