

Loyd Duvall Services Today at Ranger

RANGER (RNS) — Funeral for Loyd M. Duvall, 65, who farmed near Desdemona most of his life, will be held Saturday at 10:30 a.m. in Killingsworth Chapel with the Rev. Hal McClain, pastor of the Nazarene Church in Cisco, officiating.

Burial will be in Alameda Cemetery.

Mr. Duvall died Thursday at 12:55 am. in the M. D. Anderson Hospital in Houston. He had been hospitalized six weeks.

Mr. Duvall was born in Eastland County on May 1, 1898, and was a farmer most of his life and a carpenter for the past 12 years. He married Mrs. Ramie Sammons Rose on Feb. 12 1944, in Ranger. They lived in Lufkin nine years before returning here last November.

Surviving are his wife, Mrs. Ramie Duvall; one daughter, Mrs. Barney Belyeu of Levelland; two step-daughters, Susie M. Bratton of Ranger and Lucy Colene Coffey of Ranger; four step-sons, J. C. Rose of Orange and Owen, Marvin and Joe E. Rose, all of Ranger; three grandchildren, and four great-grandchildren.
